2011 – 2012 Tax Levy = \$15,233,119

2012 – 2013 Tax Levy = \$15,707,166

3.11% Increase





Levy Cap Can Be Over 2%

The Cortland City School's tax levy can increase by more than 2%. The calculation is an 8 step process that includes cap exemptions and a tax base growth factor

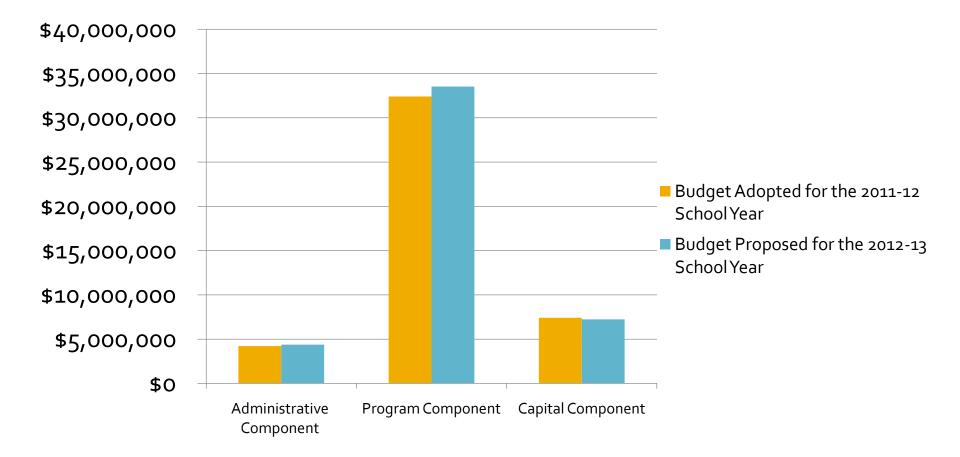

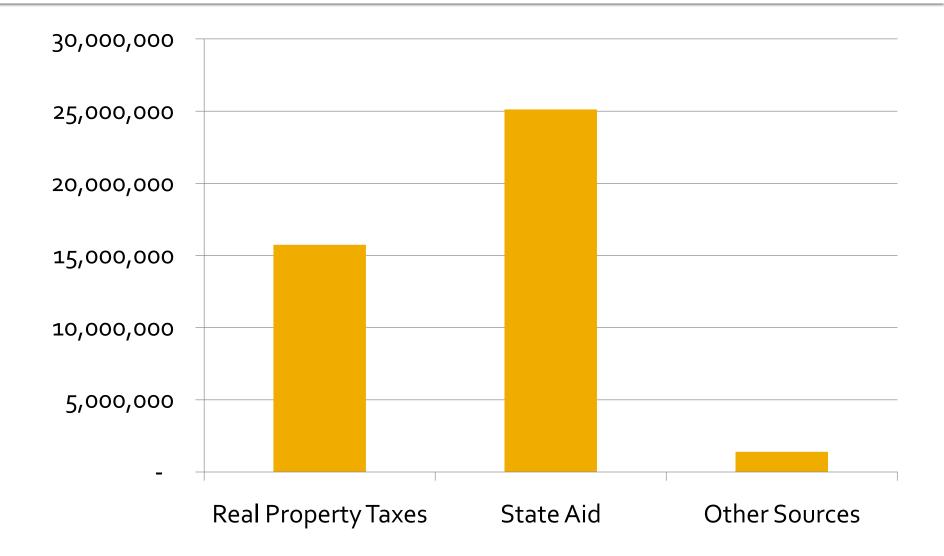
