Each child will need to bring these items in on the first day of school.

These items must be labeled:

- \$3.00 cash for a headset (new Virgil students only)
- \$5.00 cash for the Weekly Reader Magazine subscription (cash only)
- *** Always put money in an envelope labeled with your child's name and purpose.
- 4 sturdy plastic pocket folders with horizontal pockets-1 blue, 1 red, 1 green & 1 yellow (colors and plastic material are very important)
- 1 take-home folder with horizontal pockets-any color or appropriate design
- Dry-erase board size 9x12 (preferably 2 sided white/lined)
- 1 small sturdy zipper pouch for supplies

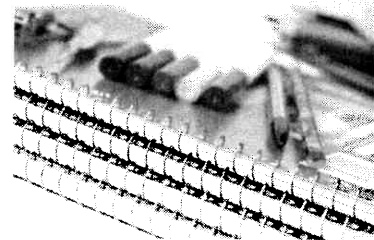
