



- Assignments for one week will be written in the classroom. These assignments will be posted on the first day of each week. Students will be given time in class to copy the assignments into their Agendas.
- Homework needs to be produced by each student; copying another person's work is not consistent with qualities of honesty and integrity.
- Homework needs to be completed by class time on the "due" date. Late homework will be
 accepted with a 25% reduction in grade up to the day of the unit test, but a 50% reduction in
 grade after the unit test.



- Students usually need to make an appointment with the teacher if they have missed class.

Students are expected to use their notebooks to complete the review sheet and ask questions if there is anything the student does not understand. Make-up tests will not be given due to low grades.
