## Homework



- Assignments for one week will be written in the classroom. These **assignments will be posted on the first day of each week**. Students will be given time in class to copy the assignments into their Agendas.
- Homework needs to be produced by each student; copying another person's work is not consistent with qualities of honesty and integrity.
- Homework needs to be **completed by class time** on the "due" date. Late homework will be accepted with a 25% reduction in grade up to the day of the unit test, but a 50% reduction in grade after the unit test.



## Extra Help or Class Make Up Time



- Students usually need to make an appointment with the teacher if they have missed class.

## Rules

- Students will be given a detailed review sheet to complete before each unit test. Any late homework for the unit needs to be turned in the day of the unit test for a 25% reduction in grade. Students are expected to use their notebooks to complete the review sheet and ask questions if there is anything the student does not understand. Make-up tests will not be given due to low grades.
