Every state determines allocation per district or building; we get it for the district. We are directed to a portal and then we apply for funding. We are always on time with our application. Typically in Nov districts are notified that you are approved. In January we were notified that our application was held up and was going through a "desk review." Katie, Kris and Bob are part of the section 1 - 3 portion of the desk review. They are awaiting further information. The next Director of Curriculum and Instruction will take this on next year. Title 1 - typically for professional salaries, in district private schools are able to pull out of this money as well Title II - typically for professional learning, travel expenses to conferences, mentoring, etc Title IV - allows us to develop some new programs: First Lego League, E-sports, etc We might not know our allocations until the end of May or June.
