Cortland Enlarged City School District Plain Language Summary of Dress Code

At all times Cortland City School students should dress neatly.

- Undergarments may not be exposed.
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be mid thigh or longer.
- The abdominal area may not be exposed. There can be no gap front or back, between your pants and top, either standing, sitting or bending.
- Students must wear the bottom wearing apparel (pants, jeans, etc.) at appropriate level at the waistline.

The following are prohibited:

- Wallet chains
- Non-prescription dark glasses
- Hats, caps, bandanas, sunglasses inside buildings/classrooms
- Pagers, cell phones, personal stereo systems, or other electronic communication devices
- Spiked accessories of any sort
- T-shirts, patches, belt buckles, necklaces, and other wearing apparel that displays offensive, suggestive or inappropriate words, pictures, or advertisements
- Strapless or spaghetti strap tops, muscle shirts, tank tops, tube tops, or any excessively revealing clothing, including back-less tops and see-through clothing
- Pajamas, sleep wear or slippers
- Beach shoes
- Full-length coats and rainwear inside the school
- Backpacks and notebooks with offensive, suggestive or inappropriate symbols, initials, sayings or pictures
- Writing or graphics on seats of pants or shorts
